5. REPORT FROM THE EMERGENCY MANAGER

Today, Monday, August 10th is the 1st day for staff professional development at the MHPSA. The Academy is fully staff excluding the principal at the high school, with interviews occurring this week, and one additional math teacher.

Last month the board had questions regarding the appearance of the buildings and lawns at our former schools which are now owned by the Michigan Landbank. The Emergency Manager reported that all of properties have been mowed and are scheduled to have any broken windows boarded up in the near future.

Regarding the status of Glendale Elementary, Mr. Schiller stated that he had been in contact with the Landbank, and then asked Mrs. Rankin, who also is a representative of the Men & Women of Character Association, if she could update the Board on the group's efforts. Mrs. Rankin reported that the Men & Women of Character are now in possession of the building with stipulations. The building will be used for many of the programs that the organization has been involved with over the years, and they will also be hopefully leasing space to other community service organizations. She also stated that they have received some grant monies to get the building up and running, and are continuing to explore other funding opportunities.

Next, the Emergency Manager discussed the recent auction at Martin Luther King, Jr. Elementary. He said that the auction went very well, and that he hopes to have the final profit figures at the next board meeting. He went on to report that the potential purchase of MLK did not occur, but we were able to retain the \$7,500 in earnest money that was collected through the signed Purchase Agreement. Mr. Schiller stated that there are still two potential buyers interested in MLK. One potential buyer has been identified by Mr. Darryl Todd of Muskegon First, who he will be meeting with this week, and the second from our Realtor who has been communicating with a group, that has purchased several of Muskegon's surplus schools. This group has expressed an interest in buying the building, but on a land contract. He also reported that due to the efforts of staff, we have found out that the land to the east of MLK belongs to the MHPS, and not the City of Muskegon Heights as originally thought.

Finally, Mr. Schiller introduced Mr. John Lewis, the District's Fiscal Control Manager, who gave the Board an update on the District's deficit elimination plan.
