

***It's Time...*** for children and youth in Muskegon to have a safe, supervised place to learn, play and be active.

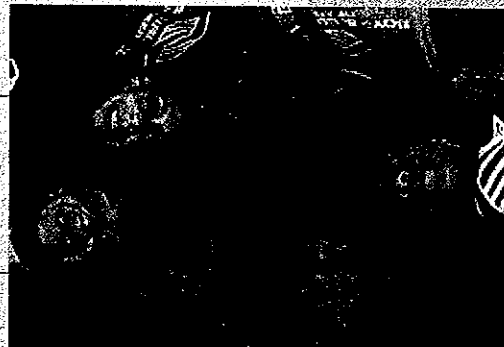

***It's Time...*** where youth will receive educational resources to supplement their school experience. Area school data reflects that about 1/4 of urban high school students drop out of school.\*

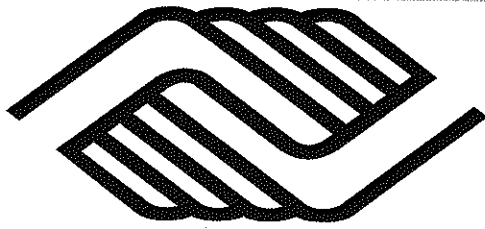
***It's Time...*** for affordable programs and activities for children and youth. More than 95% of school age children in Muskegon's urban core qualify for reduced or free lunch.\*

***It's Time...*** to stop placing blame, and to take action. Together, using community resources, we can find solutions. We can change the future for children and youth who need it most.

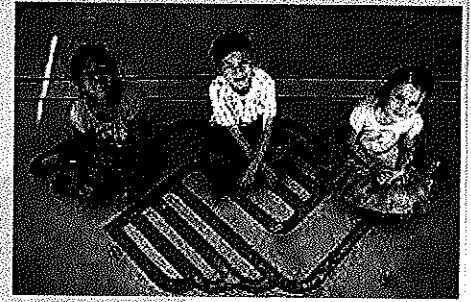

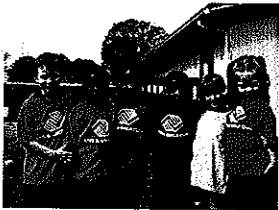

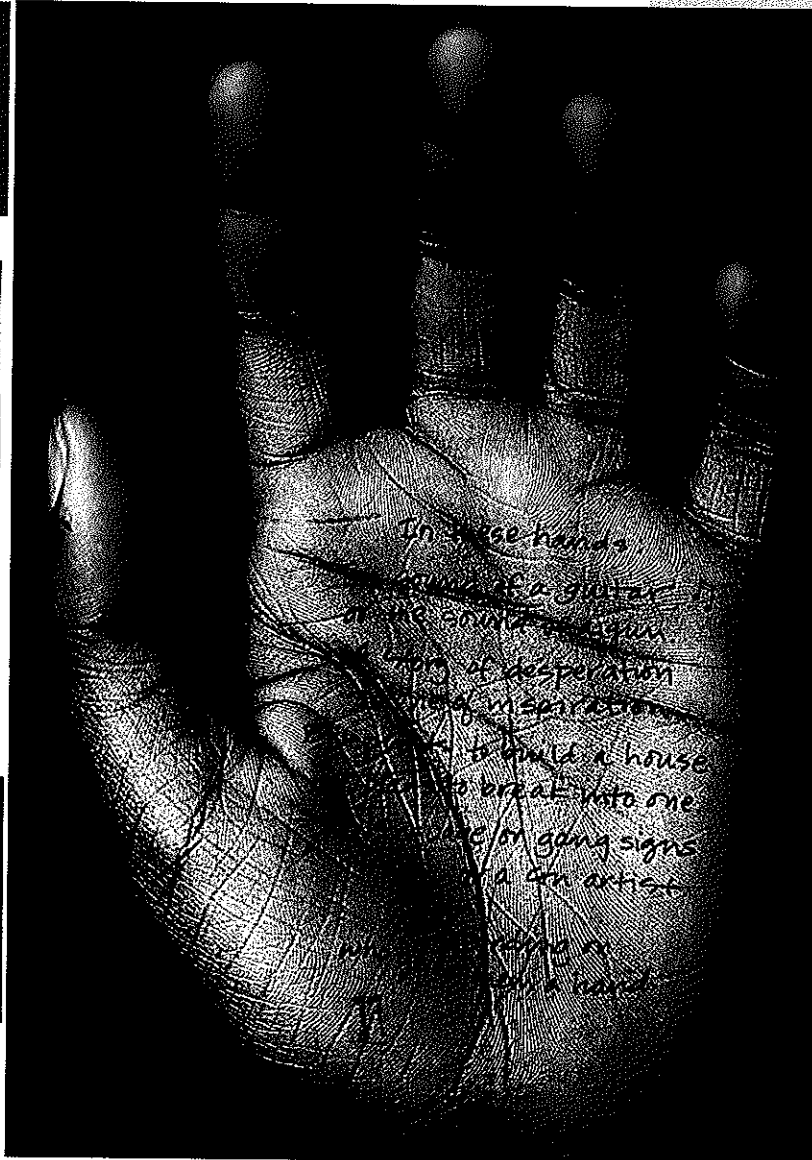
